1,000 Books Before Kindergarten – Early Childhood Literacy Program

For babies–preschoolers Research shows that the most reliable predictor of school success is being read to at home during early childhood. The brain develops more rapidly during the first three years of a child's life than at any other time during the lifespan. Reading to children from an early age can help close the vocabulary gap and prepare children to enter kindergarten with the skills they need to succeed. Simply register at the Youth Reference Desk at any time throughout the year. You'll get a folder with more information and your first reading log. Kids will get a free book when they've reached 1,000 books! There is now a 1,000 Books Before Kindergarten app available for iPod and Android. Ask us about it.
