After 86 years of providing service to the community, the Milford Public Library continues to evolve to meet the needs of residents of all ages. New services added recently include: e-books (including Overdrive Advantage, available only to Milford residents), digital magazines, and an upgrade to fiber Internet service. Damaged sidewalks, including both accessible ramps, were replaced. New humidifiers were brought online to provide a more comfortable atmosphere and to protect the wood in the building. Don't worry, traditional services haven't disappeared at all. The library continues to provide print materials, meeting space, programming and personal customer service.

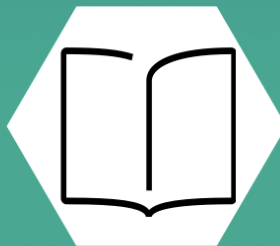
