- 1) The Library does not allow petitioning, solicitation, distribution of literature or leaflets, canvassing or similar types of appeals by members of the public within the facility.
- 2) Groups or individuals who wish to petition, solicit, canvass or distribute literature to the public outside of the facility may do so as long as they do not impede access by the public to the facility or interfere with the use of the facility.
- 3) Any activity as listed above does not indicate Library endorsement of the issue(s) involved in any such campaign.
- 4) The Milford Public Library is a voting precinct. As such, any activities related to campaigns must be in adherence to state election laws while voting is taking place. Precinct workers, not the Library, are responsible for enforcing these laws.
